The Department of Health and Human Services may be able to help you and your family with assistance when times are tough.

- To determine if you are eligible, complete and submit an application as noted in the boxes above.
- Once your application is assigned to someone, an appointment will be scheduled for a required telephone interview.
 - *The appointment notice will be sent to you by mail.*
- A Verification Checklist may be sent to you if more information is needed such as proof of income. Turning in proof of income with your completed application will help us make a quicker determination. Some examples of proof of income are:
 - *Your last 30 days of Check Stubs*
 - *An Employer Statement of Wages*
 - *Unemployment Benefit Award Letter*
- You can report changes, upload documents, sign up for text or email alerts and check the status of your application on your MIBridges account. There are also community resources and contact information available on the website as well.

Due to recent policy changes some full-time college students and people with 2 or more drug felonies may now **be eligible for Food Assistance.*
